

# Leviticus 15

1 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup> and to Aaron<sup>H175</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 2 Speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, and say<sup>H559</sup> unto them, When any<sup>H376</sup> man<sup>H376</sup> hath a running issue<sup>H2100</sup> out of his flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, because of his issue<sup>H2101</sup> he is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>. 3 And this shall be his uncleanness<sup>H2932</sup> in his issue<sup>H2101</sup>: whether his flesh<sup>H1320</sup> run<sup>H7325</sup> with his issue<sup>H2101</sup>, or his flesh<sup>H1320</sup> be stopped<sup>H2856</sup> from his issue<sup>H2101</sup>, it is his uncleanness<sup>H2932</sup>. 4 Every bed<sup>H4904</sup>, whereon he lieth<sup>H7901</sup> that hath the issue<sup>H2100</sup>, is unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: and every thing<sup>H3627</sup>, whereon he sitteth<sup>H3427</sup>, shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup>. 5 And whosoever<sup>H376</sup> toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> his bed<sup>H4904</sup> shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 6 And he that sitteth<sup>H3427</sup> on any thing<sup>H3627</sup> whereon he sat<sup>H3427</sup> that hath the issue<sup>H2100</sup> shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 7 And he that toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> the flesh<sup>H1320</sup> of him that hath the issue<sup>H2100</sup> shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 8 And if he that hath the issue<sup>H2100</sup> spit<sup>H7556</sup> upon him that is clean<sup>H2889</sup>, then he shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 9 And what saddle<sup>H4817</sup> soever he rideth<sup>H7392</sup> upon that hath the issue<sup>H2100</sup> shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup>. 10 And whosoever toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> any thing that was under him shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>: and he that beareth<sup>H5375</sup> any of those things shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 11 And whomsoever he toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> that hath the issue<sup>H2100</sup>, and hath not rinsed<sup>H7857</sup> his hands<sup>H3027</sup> in water<sup>H4325</sup>, he shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 12 And the vessel<sup>H3627</sup> of earth<sup>H2789</sup>, that he toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> which hath the issue<sup>H2100</sup>, shall be broken<sup>H7665</sup>: and every vessel<sup>H3627</sup> of wood<sup>H6086</sup> shall be rinsed<sup>H7857</sup> in water<sup>H4325</sup>. 13 And when he that hath an issue<sup>H2100</sup> is cleansed<sup>H2891</sup> of his issue<sup>H2101</sup>, then he shall number<sup>H5608</sup> to himself seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> for his cleansing<sup>H2893</sup>, and wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> his flesh<sup>H1320</sup> in running<sup>H2416</sup> water<sup>H4325</sup>, and shall be clean<sup>H2891</sup>. 14 And on the eighth<sup>H8066</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> he shall take<sup>H3947</sup> to him two<sup>H8147</sup> turtledoves<sup>H8449</sup>, or two<sup>H8147</sup> young<sup>H1121</sup> pigeons<sup>H3123</sup>, and come<sup>H935</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> unto the door<sup>H6607</sup> of the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> of the congregation<sup>H4150</sup>, and give<sup>H5414</sup> them unto the priest<sup>H3548</sup>. 15 And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall offer<sup>H6213</sup> them, the one<sup>H259</sup> for a sin offering<sup>H2403</sup>, and the other<sup>H259</sup> for a burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup>, and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall make an atonement<sup>H3722</sup> for him before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for his issue<sup>H2101</sup>. 16 And if any man's<sup>H376</sup> seed<sup>H2233</sup> of copulation<sup>H7902</sup> go out<sup>H3318</sup> from him, then he shall wash<sup>H7364</sup> all his flesh<sup>H1320</sup> in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 17 And every garment<sup>H899</sup>, and every skin<sup>H5785</sup>, whereon is the seed<sup>H2233</sup> of copulation<sup>H7902</sup>, shall be washed<sup>H3526</sup> with water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 18 The woman<sup>H802</sup> also with whom man<sup>H376</sup> shall lie<sup>H7901</sup> with seed<sup>H2233</sup> of copulation<sup>H7902</sup>, they shall both bathe<sup>H7364</sup> themselves in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>.

19 And if a woman<sup>H802</sup> have an issue<sup>H2100</sup>, and her issue<sup>H2101</sup> in her flesh<sup>H1320</sup> be blood<sup>H1818</sup>, she shall be put apart<sup>H5079</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>: and whosoever toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> her shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 20 And every thing that she lieth<sup>H7901</sup> upon in her separation<sup>H5079</sup> shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup>: every thing also that she sitteth<sup>H3427</sup> upon shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup>. 21 And whosoever toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> her bed<sup>H4904</sup> shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 22 And whosoever toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> any thing<sup>H3627</sup> that she sat<sup>H3427</sup> upon shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 23 And if it be on her bed<sup>H4904</sup>, or on any thing<sup>H3627</sup> whereon she sitteth<sup>H3427</sup>, when he toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> it, he shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. 24 And if any man<sup>H376</sup> lie<sup>H7901</sup> with her at all<sup>H7901</sup>, and her flowers<sup>H5079</sup> be upon him, he shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>; and all the bed<sup>H4904</sup> whereon he lieth<sup>H7901</sup> shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup>. 25 And if a woman<sup>H802</sup> have<sup>H2100</sup> an issue<sup>H2101</sup> of her blood<sup>H1818</sup> many<sup>H7227</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> out<sup>H3808</sup> of the time<sup>H6256</sup> of her separation<sup>H5079</sup>, or if it run<sup>H2100</sup> beyond the time<sup>H5921</sup> of her separation<sup>H5079</sup>; all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of the issue<sup>H2101</sup> of her uncleanness<sup>H2932</sup> shall be as the days<sup>H3117</sup> of her separation<sup>H5079</sup>: she shall be unclean<sup>H2931</sup>. 26 Every bed<sup>H4904</sup> whereon

she lieth<sup>H7901</sup> all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of her issue<sup>H2101</sup> shall be unto her as the bed<sup>H4904</sup> of her separation<sup>H5079</sup>: and whatsoever<sup>H3627</sup> she sitteth<sup>H3427</sup> upon shall be unclean<sup>H2931</sup>, as the uncleanness<sup>H2932</sup> of her separation<sup>H5079</sup>. **27** And whosoever toucheth<sup>H5060</sup> those things shall be unclean<sup>H2930</sup>, and shall wash<sup>H3526</sup> his clothes<sup>H899</sup>, and bathe<sup>H7364</sup> himself in water<sup>H4325</sup>, and be unclean<sup>H2930</sup> until the even<sup>H6153</sup>. **28** But if she be cleansed<sup>H2891</sup> of her issue<sup>H2101</sup>, then she shall number<sup>H5608</sup> to herself seven<sup>H7651</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>, and after<sup>H310</sup> that she shall be clean<sup>H2891</sup>. **29** And on the eighth<sup>H8066</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> she shall take<sup>H3947</sup> unto her two<sup>H8147</sup> turtles<sup>H8449</sup>, or two<sup>H8147</sup> young<sup>H1121</sup> pigeons<sup>H3123</sup>, and bring<sup>H935</sup> them unto the priest<sup>H3548</sup>, to the door<sup>H6607</sup> of the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> of the congregation<sup>H4150</sup>. **30** And the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall offer<sup>H6213</sup> the one<sup>H259</sup> for a sin offering<sup>H2403</sup>, and the other<sup>H259</sup> for a burnt offering<sup>H5930</sup>; and the priest<sup>H3548</sup> shall make an atonement<sup>H3722</sup> for her before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> for the issue<sup>H2101</sup> of her uncleanness<sup>H2932</sup>. **31** Thus shall ye separate<sup>H5144</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> from their uncleanness<sup>H2932</sup>; that they die<sup>H4191</sup> not in their uncleanness<sup>H2932</sup>, when they defile<sup>H2930</sup> my tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup> that is among<sup>H8432</sup> them. **32** This is the law<sup>H8451</sup> of him that hath an issue<sup>H2100</sup>, and of him whose seed<sup>H2233 H7902</sup> goeth<sup>H3318</sup> from him, and is defiled<sup>H2930</sup> therewith; **33** And of her that is sick<sup>H1739</sup> of her flowers<sup>H5079</sup>, and of him that hath<sup>H2100</sup> an issue<sup>H2101</sup>, of the man<sup>H2145</sup>, and of the woman<sup>H5347</sup>, and of him<sup>H376</sup> that lieth<sup>H7901</sup> with her that is unclean<sup>H2931</sup>.
