

# Luke 23

1 And<sup>G2532</sup> the whole<sup>G537</sup> multitude<sup>G4128</sup> of them<sup>G846</sup> arose<sup>G450</sup>, and led<sup>G71</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> unto<sup>G1909</sup> Pilate<sup>G4091</sup>. 2 And<sup>G1161</sup> they began<sup>G756</sup> to accuse<sup>G2723</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, We found<sup>G2147</sup> this<sup>G5126</sup> fellow perverting<sup>G1294</sup> the nation<sup>G1484</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> forbidding<sup>G2967</sup> to give<sup>G1325</sup> tribute<sup>G5411</sup> to Caesar<sup>G2541</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup> that he himself<sup>G1438</sup> is<sup>G1511</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup> a King<sup>G935</sup>. 3 And<sup>G1161</sup> Pilate<sup>G4091</sup> asked<sup>G1905</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, Art<sup>G1488</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> the King<sup>G935</sup> of the Jews<sup>G2453</sup>? And<sup>G1161</sup> he answered<sup>G611</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> and said<sup>G5346</sup>, Thou<sup>G4771</sup> sayest<sup>G3004</sup> it. 4 Then<sup>G1161</sup> said<sup>G2036</sup> Pilate<sup>G4091</sup> to<sup>G4314</sup> the chief priests<sup>G749</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> to the people<sup>G3793</sup>, I find<sup>G2147</sup> no<sup>G3762</sup> fault<sup>G158</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> this<sup>G5129</sup> man<sup>G444</sup>. 5 And<sup>G1161</sup> they were the more fierce<sup>G2001</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup> G3754, He stirreth up<sup>G383</sup> the people<sup>G2992</sup>, teaching<sup>G1321</sup> throughout<sup>G2596</sup> all<sup>G3650</sup> Jewry<sup>G2449</sup>, beginning<sup>G756</sup> from<sup>G575</sup> Galilee<sup>G1056</sup> to<sup>G2193</sup> this place<sup>G5602</sup>. 6 When<sup>G1161</sup> Pilate<sup>G4091</sup> heard<sup>G191</sup> of Galilee<sup>G1056</sup>, he asked<sup>G1905</sup> whether<sup>G1487</sup> the man<sup>G444</sup> were<sup>G2076</sup> a Galilaean<sup>G1057</sup>. 7 And<sup>G2532</sup> as soon as he knew<sup>G1921</sup> that<sup>G3754</sup> he belonged<sup>G2076</sup> unto<sup>G1537</sup> Herod's<sup>G2264</sup> jurisdiction<sup>G1849</sup>, he sent<sup>G375</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> to<sup>G4314</sup> Herod<sup>G2264</sup>, who<sup>G5607</sup> himself<sup>G846</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> was<sup>G5607</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> Jerusalem<sup>G2414</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> that<sup>G5025</sup> time<sup>G2250</sup>. 8 And<sup>G1161</sup> when Herod<sup>G2264</sup> saw<sup>G1492</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup>, he was exceeding<sup>G3029</sup> glad<sup>G5463</sup>. for<sup>G1063</sup> he was<sup>G2258</sup> desirous<sup>G2309</sup> to see<sup>G1492</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> of<sup>G1537</sup> a long<sup>G2425</sup> season, because<sup>G1223</sup> he had heard<sup>G191</sup> many things<sup>G4183</sup> of<sup>G4012</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> he hoped<sup>G1679</sup> to have seen<sup>G1492</sup> some<sup>G5100</sup> miracle<sup>G4592</sup> done<sup>G1096</sup> by<sup>G5259</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>. 9 Then<sup>G1161</sup> he questioned<sup>G1905</sup> with him<sup>G846</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> many<sup>G2425</sup> words<sup>G3056</sup>, but<sup>G1161</sup> he<sup>G846</sup> answered<sup>G611</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> nothing<sup>G3762</sup>. 10 And<sup>G1161</sup> the chief priests<sup>G749</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> scribes<sup>G1122</sup> stood<sup>G2476</sup> and vehemently<sup>G2159</sup> accused<sup>G2723</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>. 11 And<sup>G1161</sup> Herod<sup>G2264</sup> with<sup>G4862</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> men of war<sup>G4753</sup> set<sup>G1848</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> at nought<sup>G1848</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> mocked<sup>G1702</sup> him, and arrayed<sup>G4016</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> in a gorgeous<sup>G2986</sup> robe<sup>G2066</sup>, and sent<sup>G375</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> again<sup>G375</sup> to Pilate<sup>G4091</sup>. 12 And<sup>G1161</sup> G3739 the same<sup>G1722</sup> day<sup>G2250</sup> Pilate<sup>G4091</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> Herod<sup>G2264</sup> were made<sup>G1096</sup> friends<sup>G5384</sup> together<sup>G3326</sup> G5037 G240 : for<sup>G1063</sup> before<sup>G4391</sup> they were<sup>G5607</sup> at<sup>G1722</sup> enmity<sup>G2189</sup> between<sup>G4314</sup> themselves<sup>G1438</sup>.

13 And<sup>G1161</sup> Pilate<sup>G4091</sup>, when he had called together<sup>G4779</sup> the chief priests<sup>G749</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> the rulers<sup>G758</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> the people<sup>G2992</sup>, 14 Said<sup>G2036</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> them<sup>G846</sup>, Ye have brought<sup>G4374</sup> this<sup>G5129</sup> man<sup>G444</sup> unto me<sup>G3427</sup>, as<sup>G5613</sup> one that perverteth<sup>G654</sup> the people<sup>G2992</sup>: and<sup>G2532</sup>, behold<sup>G2400</sup>, I<sup>G1473</sup>, having examined<sup>G350</sup> him before<sup>G1799</sup> you<sup>G5216</sup>, have found<sup>G2147</sup> no<sup>G3762</sup> fault<sup>G158</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> this<sup>G5126</sup> man<sup>G444</sup> touching those things<sup>G3739</sup> whereof<sup>G2596</sup> ye accuse<sup>G2723</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>. 15 No<sup>G235</sup>, nor yet<sup>G3761</sup> Herod<sup>G2264</sup>: for<sup>G1063</sup> I sent<sup>G375</sup> you<sup>G5209</sup> to<sup>G4314</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>; and<sup>G2532</sup>, lo<sup>G2400</sup>, nothing<sup>G3762</sup> worthy<sup>G514</sup> of death<sup>G2288</sup> is<sup>G2076</sup> done<sup>G4238</sup> unto him<sup>G846</sup>. 16 I will<sup>G3811</sup> therefore<sup>G3767</sup> chastise<sup>G3811</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, and release<sup>G630</sup> him. 17 (For<sup>G1161</sup> of necessity<sup>G318</sup> he must<sup>G2192</sup> release<sup>G630</sup> one<sup>G1520</sup> unto them<sup>G846</sup> at<sup>G2596</sup> the feast<sup>G1859</sup>.) 18 And<sup>G1161</sup> they cried out<sup>G349</sup> all at once<sup>G3826</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, Away with this<sup>G5126</sup> man, and<sup>G1161</sup> release<sup>G630</sup> unto us<sup>G2254</sup> Barabbas<sup>G912</sup>: 19 (Who<sup>G3748</sup> for<sup>G2258</sup> G1223 a certain<sup>G5100</sup> sedition<sup>G4714</sup> made<sup>G1096</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the city<sup>G4172</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> for murder<sup>G5408</sup>, was cast<sup>G906</sup> into<sup>G1519</sup> prison<sup>G5438</sup>.) 20 Pilate<sup>G4091</sup> therefore<sup>G3767</sup>, willing<sup>G2309</sup> to release<sup>G630</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup>, spake<sup>G4377</sup> again<sup>G3825</sup> to them<sup>G4377</sup>. 21 But<sup>G1161</sup> they cried<sup>G2019</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, Crucify<sup>G4717</sup> him, crucify<sup>G4717</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>. 22 And<sup>G1161</sup> he said<sup>G2036</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> them<sup>G846</sup> the third time<sup>G5154</sup>, Why<sup>G1063</sup>, what<sup>G5101</sup> evil<sup>G2556</sup> hath<sup>G4160</sup> he<sup>G3778</sup> done<sup>G4160</sup>? I have found<sup>G2147</sup> no<sup>G3762</sup> cause<sup>G158</sup> of death<sup>G2288</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>: I will<sup>G3811</sup> therefore<sup>G3767</sup> chastise<sup>G3811</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, and let him go<sup>G630</sup>. 23 And<sup>G1161</sup> they were instant<sup>G1945</sup> with loud<sup>G3173</sup> voices<sup>G5456</sup>, requiring<sup>G154</sup> that he<sup>G846</sup> might be crucified<sup>G4717</sup>. And<sup>G2532</sup> the voices<sup>G5456</sup> of them<sup>G846</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> of the chief priests<sup>G749</sup> prevailed<sup>G2729</sup>. 24 And<sup>G1161</sup> Pilate<sup>G4091</sup> gave sentence<sup>G1948</sup> that it should be as<sup>G1096</sup> they<sup>G846</sup> required<sup>G155</sup>. 25 And<sup>G1161</sup> he released<sup>G630</sup> unto them<sup>G846</sup> him that for<sup>G1223</sup> sedition<sup>G4714</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> murder<sup>G5408</sup> was cast<sup>G906</sup> into<sup>G1519</sup> prison<sup>G5438</sup>, whom<sup>G3739</sup> they had desired<sup>G154</sup>; but<sup>G1161</sup> he delivered<sup>G3860</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> to their<sup>G846</sup> will<sup>G2307</sup>.

26 And<sup>G2532</sup> as<sup>G5613</sup> they led<sup>G520</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> away<sup>G520</sup>, they laid hold upon<sup>G1949</sup> one<sup>G5100</sup> Simon<sup>G4613</sup>, a Cyrenian<sup>G2956</sup>, coming<sup>G2064</sup> out of<sup>G575</sup> the country<sup>G68</sup>, and on<sup>G2007</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> they laid<sup>G2007</sup> the cross<sup>G4716</sup>, that he might bear<sup>G5342</sup> it

after<sup>G3693</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup>. **27** And<sup>G1161</sup> there followed<sup>G190</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> a great<sup>G4183</sup> company<sup>G4128</sup> of people<sup>G2992</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> of women<sup>G1135</sup>, which<sup>G3739</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> bewailed<sup>G2875</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> lamented<sup>G2354</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>. **28** But<sup>G1161</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> turning<sup>G4762</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> them<sup>G846</sup> said<sup>G2036</sup>, Daughters<sup>G2364</sup> of Jerusalem<sup>G2419</sup>, weep<sup>G2799</sup> not<sup>G3361</sup> for<sup>G1909</sup> me<sup>G1691</sup>, but<sup>G4133</sup> weep<sup>G2799</sup> for<sup>G1909</sup> yourselves<sup>G1438</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> for<sup>G1909</sup> your<sup>G5216</sup> children<sup>G5043</sup>. **29** For<sup>G3754</sup>, behold<sup>G2400</sup>, the days<sup>G2250</sup> are coming<sup>G2064</sup>, in<sup>G1722</sup> the which<sup>G3739</sup> they shall say<sup>G2046</sup>, Blessed<sup>G3107</sup> are the barren<sup>G4723</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the wombs<sup>G2836</sup> that<sup>G3739</sup> never<sup>G3756</sup> bare<sup>G1080</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the paps<sup>G3149</sup> which<sup>G3739</sup> never<sup>G3756</sup> gave suck<sup>G2337</sup>. **30** Then<sup>G5119</sup> shall they begin<sup>G756</sup> to say<sup>G3004</sup> to the mountains<sup>G3735</sup>, Fall<sup>G4098</sup> on<sup>G1909</sup> us<sup>G2248</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> to the hills<sup>G1015</sup>, Cover<sup>G2572</sup> us<sup>G2248</sup>. **31** For<sup>G3754</sup> if<sup>G1487</sup> they do<sup>G4160</sup> these things<sup>G5023</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> a green<sup>G5200</sup> tree<sup>G3586</sup>, what<sup>G5101</sup> shall be done<sup>G1096</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the dry<sup>G3584</sup>?

**32** And<sup>G1161</sup> there were also<sup>G2532</sup> two<sup>G1417</sup> other<sup>G2087</sup>, malefactors<sup>G2557</sup>, led<sup>G71</sup> with<sup>G4862</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> to be put to death<sup>G337</sup>. **33** And<sup>G2532</sup> when<sup>G3753</sup> they were come<sup>G565</sup> to<sup>G1909</sup> the place<sup>G5117</sup>, which<sup>G3588</sup> is called<sup>G2564</sup> Calvary<sup>G2898</sup>, there<sup>G1563</sup> they crucified<sup>G4717</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the malefactors<sup>G2557</sup>, one<sup>G3739</sup> on<sup>G1537</sup> the right hand<sup>G1188</sup>, and<sup>G1161</sup> the other<sup>G3739</sup> on<sup>G1537</sup> the left<sup>G710</sup>. **34** Then<sup>G1161</sup> said<sup>G3004</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup>, Father<sup>G3962</sup>, forgive<sup>G863</sup> them<sup>G846</sup>, for<sup>G1063</sup> they know<sup>G1492</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> what<sup>G5101</sup> they do<sup>G4160</sup>. And<sup>G1161</sup> they parted<sup>G1266</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> raiment<sup>G2440</sup>, and cast<sup>G906</sup> lots<sup>G2819</sup>. **35** And<sup>G2532</sup> the people<sup>G2992</sup> stood<sup>G2476</sup> beholding<sup>G2334</sup>. And<sup>G1161</sup> the rulers<sup>G758</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> with<sup>G4862</sup> them<sup>G846</sup> derided<sup>G1592</sup> him, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, He saved<sup>G4982</sup> others<sup>G243</sup>; let him save<sup>G4982</sup> himself<sup>G1438</sup>, if<sup>G1487</sup> he<sup>G3778</sup> be<sup>G2076</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup>, the chosen<sup>G1588</sup> of God<sup>G2316</sup>. **36** And<sup>G1161</sup> the soldiers<sup>G4757</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> mocked<sup>G1702</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, coming<sup>G4334</sup> to him, and<sup>G2532</sup> offering<sup>G4374</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> vinegar<sup>G3690</sup>. **37** And<sup>G2532</sup> saying<sup>G3004</sup>, If<sup>G1487</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> be<sup>G1488</sup> the king<sup>G935</sup> of the Jews<sup>G2453</sup>, save<sup>G4982</sup> thyself<sup>G4572</sup>. **38** And<sup>G1161</sup> a superscription<sup>G1923</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> was<sup>G2258</sup> written<sup>G1125</sup> over<sup>G1909</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> in letters<sup>G1121</sup> of Greek<sup>G1673</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> Latin<sup>G4513</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> Hebrew<sup>G1444</sup>, THIS<sup>G3778</sup> IS<sup>G2076</sup> THE KING<sup>G935</sup> OF THE JEWS<sup>G2453</sup>. **39** And<sup>G1161</sup> one<sup>G1520</sup> of the malefactors<sup>G2557</sup> which were hanged<sup>G2910</sup> railed<sup>G987</sup> on him<sup>G846</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, If<sup>G1487</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> be<sup>G1488</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup>, save<sup>G4982</sup> thyself<sup>G4572</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> us<sup>G2248</sup>. **40** But<sup>G1161</sup> the other<sup>G2087</sup> answering<sup>G611</sup> rebuked<sup>G2008</sup> him<sup>G846</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, Dost<sup>G5399</sup> not<sup>G3761</sup> thou<sup>G4771</sup> fear<sup>G5399</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, seeing<sup>G3754</sup> thou art<sup>G1488</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the same<sup>G846</sup> condemnation<sup>G2917</sup>? **41** And<sup>G2532</sup> we<sup>G2249</sup> indeed<sup>G3303</sup> justly<sup>G1346</sup>; for<sup>G1063</sup> we receive<sup>G618</sup> the due reward<sup>G514</sup> of our<sup>G3739</sup> deeds<sup>G4238</sup>: but<sup>G1161</sup> this man<sup>G3778</sup> hath done<sup>G4238</sup> nothing<sup>G3762</sup> amiss<sup>G824</sup>. **42** And<sup>G2532</sup> he said<sup>G3004</sup> unto Jesus<sup>G2424</sup>, Lord<sup>G2962</sup>, remember<sup>G3415</sup> me<sup>G3450</sup> when<sup>G3752</sup> thou comest<sup>G2064</sup> into<sup>G1722</sup> thy<sup>G4675</sup> kingdom<sup>G932</sup>. **43** And<sup>G2532</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> said<sup>G2036</sup> unto him<sup>G846</sup>, Verily<sup>G281</sup> I say<sup>G3004</sup> unto thee<sup>G4671</sup>, To day<sup>G4594</sup> shalt thou be<sup>G2071</sup> with<sup>G3326</sup> me<sup>G1700</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> paradise<sup>G3857</sup>.

**44** And<sup>G1161</sup> it was<sup>G2258</sup> about<sup>G5616</sup> the sixth<sup>G1623</sup> hour<sup>G5610</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> there was<sup>G1096</sup> a darkness<sup>G4655</sup> over<sup>G1909</sup> all<sup>G3650</sup> the earth<sup>G1093</sup> until<sup>G2193</sup> the ninth<sup>G1766</sup> hour<sup>G5610</sup>. **45** And<sup>G2532</sup> the sun<sup>G2246</sup> was darkened<sup>G4654</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the veil<sup>G2665</sup> of the temple<sup>G3485</sup> was rent<sup>G4977</sup> in the midst<sup>G3319</sup>. **46** And<sup>G2532</sup> when Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> had cried<sup>G5455</sup> with a loud<sup>G3173</sup> voice<sup>G5456</sup>, he said<sup>G2036</sup>, Father<sup>G3962</sup>, into<sup>G1519</sup> thy<sup>G4675</sup> hands<sup>G5495</sup> I commend<sup>G3908</sup> my<sup>G3450</sup> spirit<sup>G4151</sup>: and<sup>G2532</sup> having said<sup>G2036</sup> thus<sup>G5023</sup>, he gave up the ghost<sup>G1606</sup>. **47** Now<sup>G1161</sup> when the centurion<sup>G1543</sup> saw<sup>G1492</sup> what was done<sup>G1096</sup>, he glorified<sup>G1392</sup> God<sup>G2316</sup>, saying<sup>G3004</sup>, Certainly<sup>G3689</sup> this<sup>G3778</sup> was<sup>G2258</sup> a righteous<sup>G1342</sup> man<sup>G444</sup>. **48** And<sup>G2532</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> the people<sup>G3793</sup> that came together<sup>G4836</sup> to<sup>G1909</sup> that<sup>G5026</sup> sight<sup>G2335</sup>, beholding<sup>G2334</sup> the things which were done<sup>G1096</sup>, smote<sup>G5180</sup> their<sup>G1438</sup> breasts<sup>G4738</sup>, and returned<sup>G5290</sup>. **49** And<sup>G1161</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> acquaintance<sup>G1110</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the women<sup>G1135</sup> that followed<sup>G4870</sup> him<sup>G846</sup> from<sup>G575</sup> Galilee<sup>G1056</sup>, stood<sup>G2476</sup> afar off<sup>G3113</sup>, beholding<sup>G3708</sup> these things<sup>G5023</sup>.

**50** And<sup>G2532</sup>, behold<sup>G2400</sup>, there was a man<sup>G435</sup> named<sup>G3686</sup> Joseph<sup>G2501</sup>, a counsellor<sup>G1010</sup>; and he was a good<sup>G5225</sup> man<sup>G435</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> a just<sup>G1342</sup>: **51** (The same<sup>G3778</sup> had<sup>G4784</sup> not<sup>G3756</sup> consented<sup>G4784</sup> to the counsel<sup>G1012</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> deed<sup>G4234</sup> of them<sup>G846</sup>;) he was of<sup>G575</sup> Arimathaea<sup>G707</sup>, a city<sup>G4172</sup> of the Jews<sup>G2453</sup>: who<sup>G3739</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> himself<sup>G846</sup> waited for<sup>G4327</sup> the kingdom<sup>G932</sup> of God<sup>G2316</sup>. **52** This<sup>G3778</sup> man went<sup>G4334</sup> unto Pilate<sup>G4091</sup>, and begged<sup>G154</sup> the body<sup>G4983</sup> of Jesus<sup>G2424</sup>. **53** And<sup>G2532</sup> he took<sup>G2507</sup> it<sup>G846</sup> down<sup>G2507</sup>, and wrapped<sup>G1794</sup> it<sup>G846</sup> in linen<sup>G4616</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> laid<sup>G5087</sup> it<sup>G846</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> a sepulchre<sup>G3418</sup> that was hewn in stone<sup>G2991</sup>, wherein<sup>G3757</sup> never<sup>G3756</sup> man<sup>G3764</sup> before<sup>G3762</sup> was<sup>G2258</sup> laid<sup>G2749</sup>. **54** And<sup>G2532</sup> that day<sup>G2250</sup> was<sup>G2258</sup> the preparation<sup>G3904</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> the sabbath<sup>G4521</sup> drew on<sup>G2020</sup>. **55** And<sup>G1161</sup> the women<sup>G1135</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup>, which<sup>G3748</sup> came<sup>G2258</sup> with him<sup>G846</sup> from<sup>G1537</sup> Galilee<sup>G1056</sup>, followed after<sup>G2628</sup>, and beheld<sup>G2300</sup> the sepulchre<sup>G3419</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> how<sup>G5613</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> body<sup>G4983</sup> was laid<sup>G5087</sup>. **56** And they returned<sup>G5290</sup>, and<sup>G1161</sup>

prepared<sup>G2090</sup> spices<sup>G759</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> ointments<sup>G3464</sup>; and<sup>G2532</sup> rested<sup>G2270 G3303</sup> the sabbath day<sup>G4521</sup> according<sup>G2596</sup> to the  
commandment<sup>G1785</sup>.
