Yet ye say<sup>H559</sup>, Wherein hast thou loved<sup>H157</sup> us? Was not Esau<sup>H6215</sup> Jacob's<sup>H3290</sup> brother<sup>H251</sup>? saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: yet I loved<sup>H157</sup> Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, 3 And I hated<sup>H8130</sup> Esau<sup>H6215</sup>, and laid<sup>H7760</sup> his mountains<sup>H2022</sup> and his heritage<sup>H5159</sup> waste<sup>H8077</sup> for the dragons<sup>H8568</sup> of the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>. 4 Whereas Edom<sup>H123</sup> saith<sup>H559</sup>, We are impoverished<sup>H7567</sup>, but we will return<sup>H7725</sup> and build<sup>H1129</sup> the desolate places<sup>H2723</sup>; thus saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, They shall build<sup>H1129</sup>, but I will throw down<sup>H2040</sup>; and they shall call<sup>H7121</sup> them, The border<sup>H1366</sup> of wickedness<sup>H7564</sup>, and, The people<sup>H5971</sup> against whom the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath indignation<sup>H2194</sup> for H5704 ever H5769. 5 And your eyes shall see<sup>H7200</sup>, and ye shall say<sup>H559</sup>, The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will be magnified<sup>H1431</sup> from the border<sup>H1366</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>.²

In that ye say<sup>H559</sup>, The table<sup>H7979</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is contemptible<sup>H959</sup>. 8 And if ye offer<sup>H5066</sup> the blind<sup>H5787</sup> for sacrifice<sup>H2076</sup>, is it not evil H7451? and if ye offer H5066 the lame H6455 and sick H2470, is it not evil H7451? offer H7126 it now unto thy governor H6346; will he be pleased H7521 with thee, or accept thy person saith saith the LORD the LORD of hosts hosts 4 9 And now, I prav vou. beseech H2470 H6440 God H410 that he will be gracious unto us: this hath been by your means H3027: will he regard<sup>H5375</sup> your persons<sup>H6440</sup>? saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>.<sup>56</sup> 10 Who is there even among you that would shut<sup>H5462</sup> the doors<sup>H1817</sup> for nought? neither do ye kindle<sup>H215</sup> fire on mine altar<sup>H4196</sup> for nought<sup>H2600</sup>. I have no pleasure<sup>H2656</sup> in you, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, neither will I accept<sup>H7521</sup> an offering<sup>H4503</sup> at your hand<sup>H3027</sup>. 11 For from the rising H4217 of the sun H8121 even unto the going down of the same my name shall be great to the same shall be great to the sa among the Gentiles H1471; and in every place H4725 incense H6999 shall be offered unto my name name and a pure H2889 offering H4503: for my name H8034 shall be great among the heathen saith saith H559 the LORD H3068 of hosts H6635. 12 But ye have profaned H2490 it, in that ye say H559, The table H7979 of the LORD H3068 is polluted is polluted to fruit H5108 thereof, even his meat H400, is contemptible H959. 13 Ye said H559 also, Behold, what a weariness H4972 is it! and ye have snuffed<sup>H5301</sup> at it, saith<sup>H559</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>; and ye brought<sup>H935</sup> that which was torn<sup>H1497</sup>, and the lame<sup>H6455</sup>, and the sick H2470; thus ye brought an offering H4503: should I accept this of your hand h3027? saith the LORD<sup>H3068,7</sup> **14** But cursed<sup>H779</sup> be the deceiver<sup>H5230</sup>, which<sup>H3426</sup> hath in his flock<sup>H5739</sup> a male<sup>H2145</sup>, and voweth<sup>H5087</sup>, and sacrificeth H2076 unto the Lord a corrupt thing H7843: for I am a great King H4428, saith the LORD the LORD of hosts H6635, and my name H8034 is dreadful H3372 among the heathen H1471.8
