

# Numbers 22

1 And the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> set forward<sup>H5265</sup>, and pitched<sup>H2583</sup> in the plains<sup>H6160</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup> on this side<sup>H5676</sup> Jordan<sup>H3383</sup> by Jericho<sup>H3405</sup>. 2 And Balak<sup>H1111</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zippor<sup>H6834</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> all that Israel<sup>H3478</sup> had done<sup>H6213</sup> to the Amorites<sup>H567</sup>. 3 And Moab<sup>H4124</sup> was sore<sup>H3966</sup> afraid<sup>H1481</sup> of<sup>H6440</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>, because they were many<sup>H7227</sup>: and Moab<sup>H4124</sup> was distressed<sup>H6973</sup> because of<sup>H6440</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 4 And Moab<sup>H4124</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Midian<sup>H4080</sup>, Now shall this company<sup>H6951</sup> lick up<sup>H3897</sup> all that are round about<sup>H5439</sup> us, as the ox<sup>H7794</sup> licketh up<sup>H3897</sup> the grass<sup>H3418</sup> of the field<sup>H7704</sup>. And Balak<sup>H1111</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zippor<sup>H6834</sup> was king<sup>H4428</sup> of the Moabites<sup>H4124</sup> at that time<sup>H6256</sup>. 5 He sent<sup>H7971</sup> messengers<sup>H4397</sup> therefore unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Beor<sup>H1160</sup> to Pethor<sup>H6604</sup>, which is by the river<sup>H5104</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> of the children<sup>H1121</sup> of his people<sup>H5971</sup>, to call<sup>H7121</sup> him, saying<sup>H559</sup>, Behold, there is a people<sup>H5971</sup> come out<sup>H3318</sup> from Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>: behold, they cover<sup>H3680</sup> the face<sup>H5869</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>, and they abide<sup>H3427</sup> over against<sup>H4136</sup> me: 6 Come<sup>H3212</sup> now therefore, I pray thee, curse<sup>H779</sup> me this people<sup>H5971</sup>; for they are too mighty<sup>H6099</sup> for me: peradventure I shall prevail<sup>H3201</sup>, that we may smite<sup>H5221</sup> them, and that I may drive them out<sup>H1644</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>: for I wot<sup>H3045</sup> that he whom thou blessest<sup>H1288</sup> is blessed<sup>H1288</sup>, and he whom thou cursest<sup>H779</sup> is cursed<sup>H779</sup>. 7 And the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup> and the elders<sup>H2205</sup> of Midian<sup>H4080</sup> departed<sup>H3212</sup> with the rewards of divination<sup>H7081</sup> in their hand<sup>H3027</sup>; and they came<sup>H935</sup> unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, and spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto him the words<sup>H1697</sup> of Balak<sup>H1111</sup>. 8 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Lodge<sup>H3885</sup> here this night<sup>H3915</sup>, and I will bring<sup>H7725</sup> you word<sup>H1697</sup> again<sup>H7725</sup>, as the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto me: and the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup> abode<sup>H3427</sup> with Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>. 9 And God<sup>H430</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, What men<sup>H582</sup> are these with thee? 10 And Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto God<sup>H430</sup>, Balak<sup>H1111</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zippor<sup>H6834</sup>, king<sup>H4428</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, hath sent<sup>H7971</sup> unto me, saying, 11 Behold, there is a people<sup>H5971</sup> come out<sup>H3318</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, which covereth<sup>H3680</sup> the face<sup>H5869</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>: come<sup>H3212</sup> now, curse<sup>H6895</sup> me them; peradventure I shall be able<sup>H3201</sup> to overcome<sup>H3898</sup> them, and drive them out<sup>H1644</sup>. 12 And God<sup>H430</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, Thou shalt not go<sup>H3212</sup> with them; thou shalt not curse<sup>H779</sup> the people<sup>H5971</sup>: for they are blessed<sup>H1288</sup>. 13 And Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> rose up<sup>H6965</sup> in the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Balak<sup>H1111</sup>, Get<sup>H3212</sup> you into your land<sup>H776</sup>: for the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> refuseth<sup>H3985</sup> to give me leave<sup>H5414</sup> to go<sup>H1980</sup> with you. 14 And the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup> rose up<sup>H6965</sup>, and they went<sup>H935</sup> unto Balak<sup>H1111</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> refuseth<sup>H3985</sup> to come<sup>H1980</sup> with us.

15 And Balak<sup>H1111</sup> sent<sup>H7971</sup> yet again<sup>H3254</sup> princes<sup>H8269</sup>, more<sup>H7227</sup>, and more honourable<sup>H3513</sup> than they. 16 And they came<sup>H935</sup> to Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> to him, Thus saith<sup>H559</sup> Balak<sup>H1111</sup> the son<sup>H1121</sup> of Zippor<sup>H6834</sup>, Let nothing, I pray thee, hinder<sup>H4513</sup> thee from coming<sup>H1980</sup> unto me: 17 For I will promote<sup>H3513</sup> thee unto very<sup>H3966</sup> great<sup>H3513</sup> honour<sup>H3513</sup>, and I will do<sup>H6213</sup> whatsoever thou sayest<sup>H559</sup> unto me: come<sup>H3212</sup> therefore, I pray thee, curse<sup>H6895</sup> me this people<sup>H5971</sup>. 18 And Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> answered<sup>H6030</sup> and said<sup>H559</sup> unto the servants<sup>H5650</sup> of Balak<sup>H1111</sup>, If Balak<sup>H1111</sup> would give<sup>H5414</sup> me his house<sup>H1004</sup> full<sup>H4393</sup> of silver<sup>H3701</sup> and gold<sup>H2091</sup>, I cannot<sup>H3201</sup> go beyond<sup>H5674</sup> the word<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> my God<sup>H430</sup>, to do<sup>H6213</sup> less<sup>H6996</sup> or more<sup>H1419</sup>. 19 Now therefore, I pray you, tarry<sup>H3427</sup> ye also here this night<sup>H3915</sup>, that I may know<sup>H3045</sup> what the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will say<sup>H1696</sup> unto me more<sup>H3254</sup>. 20 And God<sup>H430</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> at night<sup>H3915</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, If the men<sup>H582</sup> come<sup>H935</sup> to call<sup>H7121</sup> thee, rise up<sup>H6965</sup>, and go<sup>H3212</sup> with them; but yet<sup>H389</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup> which I shall say<sup>H1696</sup> unto thee, that shalt thou do<sup>H6213</sup>. 21 And Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> rose up<sup>H6965</sup> in the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, and saddled<sup>H2280</sup> his ass<sup>H860</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> with the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup>.

22 And God's<sup>H430</sup> anger<sup>H639</sup> was kindled<sup>H2734</sup> because he went<sup>H1980</sup>: and the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> stood<sup>H3320</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup> for an adversary<sup>H7854</sup> against him. Now he was riding<sup>H7392</sup> upon his ass<sup>H860</sup>, and his two<sup>H8147</sup> servants<sup>H5288</sup> were with him. 23 And the ass<sup>H860</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> standing<sup>H5324</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup>, and his sword<sup>H2719</sup> drawn<sup>H8025</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>: and the ass<sup>H860</sup> turned aside<sup>H5186</sup> out of the way<sup>H1870</sup>, and went<sup>H3212</sup> into the

field<sup>H7704</sup>: and Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> smote<sup>H5221</sup> the ass<sup>H860</sup>, to turn<sup>H5186</sup> her into the way<sup>H1870</sup>. **24** But the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> stood<sup>H5975</sup> in a path<sup>H4934</sup> of the vineyards<sup>H3754</sup>, a wall<sup>H1447</sup> being on this side, and a wall<sup>H1447</sup> on that side. **25** And when the ass<sup>H860</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, she thrust<sup>H3905</sup> herself unto the wall<sup>H7023</sup>, and crushed<sup>H3905</sup> Balaam's<sup>H1109</sup> foot<sup>H7272</sup> against the wall<sup>H7023</sup>: and he smote<sup>H5221</sup> her again<sup>H3254</sup>. **26** And the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> went<sup>H5674</sup> further<sup>H3254</sup>, and stood<sup>H5975</sup> in a narrow<sup>H6862</sup> place<sup>H4725</sup>, where was no way<sup>H1870</sup> to turn<sup>H5186</sup> either to the right hand<sup>H3225</sup> or to the left<sup>H8040</sup>. **27** And when the ass<sup>H860</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, she fell down<sup>H7257</sup> under Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>: and Balaam's<sup>H1109</sup> anger<sup>H639</sup> was kindled<sup>H2734</sup>, and he smote<sup>H5221</sup> the ass<sup>H860</sup> with a staff<sup>H4731</sup>. **28** And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> opened<sup>H6605</sup> the mouth<sup>H6310</sup> of the ass<sup>H860</sup>, and she said<sup>H559</sup> unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, What have I done<sup>H6213</sup> unto thee, that thou hast smitten<sup>H5221</sup> me these three<sup>H7969</sup> times<sup>H7272</sup>? **29** And Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the ass<sup>H860</sup>, Because thou hast mocked<sup>H5953</sup> me: I would<sup>H3863</sup> there were<sup>H3426</sup> a sword<sup>H2719</sup> in mine hand<sup>H3027</sup>, for now would I kill<sup>H2026</sup> thee. **30** And the ass<sup>H860</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, Am not I thine ass<sup>H860</sup>, upon which thou hast ridden<sup>H7392</sup> ever since I was thine unto this day<sup>H3117</sup>? was I ever<sup>H5532</sup> wont<sup>H5532</sup> to do so<sup>H6213</sup> unto thee? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, Nay.<sup>45</sup> **31** Then the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> opened<sup>H1540</sup> the eyes<sup>H5869</sup> of Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, and he saw<sup>H7200</sup> the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> standing<sup>H5324</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup>, and his sword<sup>H2719</sup> drawn<sup>H8025</sup> in his hand<sup>H3027</sup>: and he bowed down<sup>H6915</sup> his head, and fell flat<sup>H7812</sup> on his face<sup>H639</sup>. **32** And the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, Wherefore hast thou smitten<sup>H5221</sup> thine ass<sup>H860</sup> these three<sup>H7969</sup> times<sup>H7272</sup>? behold, I went out<sup>H3318</sup> to withstand<sup>H7854</sup> thee, because thy way<sup>H1870</sup> is perverse<sup>H3399</sup> before me.<sup>7</sup> **33** And the ass<sup>H860</sup> saw<sup>H7200</sup> me, and turned<sup>H5186</sup> from me<sup>H6440</sup> these three<sup>H7969</sup> times<sup>H7272</sup>: unless<sup>H194</sup> she had turned<sup>H5186</sup> from me<sup>H6440</sup>, surely now also I had slain<sup>H2026</sup> thee, and saved her alive<sup>H2421</sup>. **34** And Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, I have sinned<sup>H2398</sup>, for I knew<sup>H3045</sup> not that thou stoodest<sup>H5324</sup> in the way<sup>H1870</sup> against<sup>H7125</sup> me: now therefore, if it displease thee<sup>H7489</sup> <sup>H5869</sup>, I will get me back again<sup>H7725</sup>. **35** And the angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, Go<sup>H3212</sup> with the men<sup>H582</sup>: but only<sup>H657</sup> the word<sup>H1697</sup> that I shall speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto thee, that thou shalt speak<sup>H1696</sup>. So Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> with the princes<sup>H8269</sup> of Balak<sup>H1111</sup>.

**36** And when Balak<sup>H1111</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> that Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> was come<sup>H935</sup>, he went out<sup>H3318</sup> to meet<sup>H7125</sup> him unto a city<sup>H5892</sup> of Moab<sup>H4124</sup>, which is in the border<sup>H1366</sup> of Arnon<sup>H769</sup>, which is in the utmost<sup>H7097</sup> coast<sup>H1366</sup>. **37** And Balak<sup>H1111</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, Did I not earnestly<sup>H7971</sup> send<sup>H7971</sup> unto thee to call<sup>H7121</sup> thee? wherefore camest<sup>H1980</sup> thou not unto me? am I not able<sup>H3201</sup> indeed<sup>H552</sup> to promote thee to honour<sup>H3513</sup>? **38** And Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto Balak<sup>H1111</sup>, Lo, I am come<sup>H935</sup> unto thee: have I now any power<sup>H3201</sup> at all<sup>H3201</sup> to say<sup>H1696</sup> any thing<sup>H3972</sup>? the word<sup>H1697</sup> that God<sup>H430</sup> putteth<sup>H7760</sup> in my mouth<sup>H6310</sup>, that shall I speak<sup>H1696</sup>. **39** And Balaam<sup>H1109</sup> went<sup>H3212</sup> with Balak<sup>H1111</sup>, and they came<sup>H935</sup> unto Kirjathuzoth<sup>H2351</sup> <sup>H7155</sup>. **40** And Balak<sup>H1111</sup> offered<sup>H2076</sup> oxen<sup>H1241</sup> and sheep<sup>H6629</sup>, and sent<sup>H7971</sup> to Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, and to the princes<sup>H8269</sup> that were with him. **41** And it came to pass on the morrow<sup>H1242</sup>, that Balak<sup>H1111</sup> took<sup>H3947</sup> Balaam<sup>H1109</sup>, and brought him up<sup>H5927</sup> into the high places<sup>H1116</sup> of Baal<sup>H1120</sup>, that thence he might see<sup>H7200</sup> the utmost<sup>H7097</sup> part of the people<sup>H5971</sup>.
