

# Numbers 9

1 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Sinai<sup>H5514</sup>, in the first<sup>H7223</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup> of the second<sup>H8145</sup> year<sup>H8141</sup> after they were come out<sup>H3318</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> of Egypt<sup>H4714</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 2 Let the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> also keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> at his appointed season<sup>H4150</sup>. 3 In the fourteenth<sup>H702 H6240</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> of this month<sup>H2320</sup>, at even<sup>H6153</sup>, ye shall keep<sup>H6213</sup> it in his appointed season<sup>H4150</sup>: according to all the rites<sup>H2708</sup> of it, and according to all the ceremonies<sup>H4941</sup> thereof, shall ye keep<sup>H6213</sup> it. 4 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, that they should keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup>. 5 And they kept<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> on the fourteenth<sup>H702 H6240</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> of the first<sup>H7223</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup> at even<sup>H6153</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Sinai<sup>H5514</sup>: according to all that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> commanded<sup>H6680</sup> Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, so did<sup>H6213</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 6 And there were certain men<sup>H582</sup>, who were defiled<sup>H2931</sup> by the dead body<sup>H5315</sup> of a man<sup>H120</sup>, that they could<sup>H3201</sup> not keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> on that day<sup>H3117</sup>: and they came<sup>H7126</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> Moses<sup>H4872</sup> and before<sup>H6440</sup> Aaron<sup>H175</sup> on that day<sup>H3117</sup>. 7 And those<sup>H1992</sup> men<sup>H582</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, We are defiled<sup>H2931</sup> by the dead body<sup>H5315</sup> of a man<sup>H120</sup>: wherefore are we kept back<sup>H1639</sup>, that we may not offer<sup>H7126</sup> an offering<sup>H7133</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in his appointed season<sup>H4150</sup> among<sup>H8432</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>? 8 And Moses<sup>H4872</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto them, Stand still<sup>H5975</sup>, and I will hear<sup>H8085</sup> what the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will command<sup>H6680</sup> concerning you. 9 And the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> spake<sup>H1696</sup> unto Moses<sup>H4872</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, 10 Speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup>, saying<sup>H559</sup>, If any<sup>H376</sup> man<sup>H376</sup> of you or of your posterity<sup>H1755</sup> shall be unclean<sup>H2931</sup> by reason of a dead body<sup>H5315</sup>, or be in a journey<sup>H1870</sup> afar off<sup>H7350</sup>, yet he shall keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. 11 The fourteenth<sup>H702 H6240</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup> of the second<sup>H8145</sup> month<sup>H2320</sup> at even<sup>H6153</sup> they shall keep<sup>H6213</sup> it, and eat<sup>H398</sup> it with unleavened bread<sup>H4682</sup> and bitter<sup>H4844</sup> herbs. 12 They shall leave<sup>H7604</sup> none of it unto the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, nor break<sup>H7665</sup> any bone<sup>H6106</sup> of it: according to all the ordinances<sup>H2708</sup> of the passover<sup>H6453</sup> they shall keep<sup>H6213</sup> it. 13 But the man<sup>H376</sup> that is clean<sup>H2889</sup>, and is not in a journey<sup>H1870</sup>, and forbear<sup>H2308</sup> to keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup>, even the same soul<sup>H5315</sup> shall be cut off<sup>H3772</sup> from among his people<sup>H5971</sup>: because he brought<sup>H7126</sup> not the offering<sup>H7133</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in his appointed season<sup>H4150</sup>, that man<sup>H376</sup> shall bear<sup>H5375</sup> his sin<sup>H2399</sup>. 14 And if a stranger<sup>H1616</sup> shall sojourn<sup>H1481</sup> among you, and will keep<sup>H6213</sup> the passover<sup>H6453</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, according to the ordinance<sup>H2708</sup> of the passover<sup>H6453</sup>, and according to the manner<sup>H4941</sup> thereof, so shall he do<sup>H6213</sup>: ye shall have one<sup>H259</sup> ordinance<sup>H2708</sup>, both for the stranger<sup>H1616</sup>, and for him that was born<sup>H249</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup>.

15 And on the day<sup>H3117</sup> that the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup> was reared up<sup>H6965</sup> the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> covered<sup>H3680</sup> the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup>, namely, the tent<sup>H168</sup> of the testimony<sup>H5715</sup>: and at even<sup>H6153</sup> there was upon the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup> as it were the appearance<sup>H4758</sup> of fire<sup>H784</sup>, until the morning<sup>H1242</sup>. 16 So it was always<sup>H8548</sup>: the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> covered<sup>H3680</sup> it by day, and the appearance<sup>H4758</sup> of fire<sup>H784</sup> by night<sup>H3915</sup>. 17 And when<sup>H6310</sup> the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> was taken up<sup>H5927</sup> from the tabernacle<sup>H168</sup>, then after<sup>H310</sup> that the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>: and in the place<sup>H4725</sup> where the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> abode<sup>H7931</sup>, there the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> pitched their tents<sup>H2583</sup>. 18 At the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>, and at the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> they pitched<sup>H2583</sup>: as long as<sup>H3117</sup> the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> abode<sup>H7931</sup> upon the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup> they rested<sup>H2583</sup> in their tents. 19 And when the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> tarried long<sup>H748</sup> upon the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup> many<sup>H7227</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup>, then the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> kept<sup>H8104</sup> the charge<sup>H4931</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and journeyed<sup>H5265</sup> not. 20 And so it was<sup>H3426</sup>, when the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> was a few<sup>H4557</sup> days<sup>H3117</sup> upon the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup>; according to the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> they abode<sup>H2583</sup> in their tents, and according to the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> they journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>. 21 And so it was<sup>H3426</sup>, when the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> abode from even<sup>H6153</sup> unto the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, and that the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> was taken up<sup>H5927</sup> in the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, then they journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>: whether it was by day<sup>H3119</sup> or by night<sup>H3915</sup> that the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> was taken up<sup>H5927</sup>, they journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>. 22 Or whether it were two days<sup>H3117</sup>, or a month<sup>H2320</sup>, or a year<sup>H3117</sup>, that the cloud<sup>H6051</sup> tarried<sup>H748</sup> upon the tabernacle<sup>H4908</sup>, remaining<sup>H7931</sup> thereon, the children<sup>H1121</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> abode<sup>H2583</sup> in their tents, and journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>

not: but when it was taken up<sup>H5927</sup>, they journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>. **23** At the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> they rested<sup>H2583</sup> in the tents, and at the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> they journeyed<sup>H5265</sup>: they kept<sup>H8104</sup> the charge<sup>H4931</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, at the commandment<sup>H6310</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> by the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of Moses<sup>H4872</sup>.
