1 A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. I will sing<sup>H7891</sup> of mercy<sup>H2617</sup> and judgment<sup>H4941</sup>: unto thee, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, will I sing<sup>H2167</sup>. 2 I will behave myself wisely<sup>H7919</sup> in a perfect<sup>H8549</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup>. O when wilt thou come<sup>H935</sup> unto me? I will walk<sup>H1980</sup> within<sup>H7130</sup> my house<sup>H1004</sup> with a perfect<sup>H8537</sup> heart<sup>H3824</sup>. 3 I will set<sup>H7896</sup> no wicked<sup>H1100</sup> thing<sup>H1697</sup> before mine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>: I hate<sup>H8130</sup> the work<sup>H6213</sup> of them that turn aside<sup>H7750</sup>; it shall not cleave<sup>H1692</sup> to me.<sup>1</sup> 4 A froward<sup>H6141</sup> heart<sup>H3824</sup> shall depart<sup>H5493</sup> from me: I will not know<sup>H3045</sup> a wicked<sup>H7451</sup> person. 5 Whoso privily<sup>H5643</sup> slandereth<sup>H3960 H3960</sup> his neighbour<sup>H7453</sup>, him will I cut off<sup>H6789</sup>: him that hath an high<sup>H1362</sup> look<sup>H5869</sup> and a proud<sup>H7342</sup> heart<sup>H3824</sup> will not I suffer<sup>H3201</sup>. 6 Mine eyes<sup>H5869</sup> shall be upon the faithful<sup>H539</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>, that they may dwell<sup>H3427</sup> with me: he that walketh<sup>H1980</sup> in a perfect<sup>H8549</sup> way<sup>H1870</sup>, he shall serve<sup>H8334</sup> me.<sup>2</sup> 7 He that worketh<sup>H6213</sup> deceit<sup>H7423</sup> shall not dwell<sup>H3427</sup> within<sup>H7130</sup> my house<sup>H1004</sup>: he that telleth<sup>H1696</sup> lies<sup>H8267</sup> shall not tarry<sup>H3559</sup> in my sight<sup>H5869</sup>.<sup>3</sup> 8 I will early<sup>H1242</sup> destroy<sup>H6789</sup> all the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup>; that I may cut off<sup>H3772</sup> all wicked<sup>H205</sup> doers<sup>H6466</sup> from the city<sup>H5892</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.
