**1** A Song<sup>H7892</sup> or Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. O God<sup>H430</sup>, my heart<sup>H3820</sup> is fixed<sup>H3559</sup>; I will sing<sup>H7891</sup> and give praise<sup>H2167</sup>, even with my glory<sup>H3519</sup>. **2** Awake<sup>H5782</sup>, psaltery<sup>H5035</sup> and harp<sup>H3658</sup>: I myself will awake<sup>H5782</sup> early<sup>H7837</sup>. **3** I will praise<sup>H3034</sup> thee, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, among the people<sup>H5971</sup>: and I will sing praises<sup>H2167</sup> unto thee among the nations<sup>H3816</sup>. **4** For thy mercy<sup>H2617</sup> is great<sup>H1419</sup> above the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>: and thy truth<sup>H571</sup> reacheth unto the clouds<sup>H7834</sup>. **5** Be thou exalted<sup>H7311</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup>, above the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>: and thy glory<sup>H3519</sup> above all the earth<sup>H776</sup>;

**6** That thy beloved<sup>H3039</sup> may be delivered<sup>H2502</sup>: save<sup>H3467</sup> with thy right hand<sup>H3225</sup>, and answer<sup>H6030</sup> me. **7** God<sup>H430</sup> hath spoken<sup>H1696</sup> in his holiness<sup>H6944</sup>; I will rejoice<sup>H5937</sup>, I will divide<sup>H2505</sup> Shechem<sup>H7927</sup>, and mete out<sup>H4058</sup> the valley<sup>H6010</sup> of Succoth<sup>H5523</sup>. **8** Gilead<sup>H1568</sup> is mine; Manasseh<sup>H4519</sup> is mine; Ephraim<sup>H669</sup> also is the strength<sup>H4581</sup> of mine head<sup>H7218</sup>, Judah<sup>H3063</sup> is my lawgiver<sup>H2710</sup>; **9** Moab<sup>H4124</sup> is my washpot<sup>H7366 H5518</sup>, over Edom<sup>H123</sup> will I cast out<sup>H7993</sup> my shoe<sup>H5275</sup>, over Philistia<sup>H6429</sup> will I triumph<sup>H7321</sup>. **10** Who will bring<sup>H2986</sup> me into the strong<sup>H4013</sup> city<sup>H5892</sup>? who will lead<sup>H5148</sup> me into Edom<sup>H123</sup>? **11** Wilt not thou, O God<sup>H430</sup>, who hast cast us off<sup>H2186</sup>? and wilt not thou, O God<sup>H430</sup>, go forth<sup>H3318</sup> with our hosts<sup>H6635</sup>? **12** Give<sup>H3051</sup> us help<sup>H5833</sup> from trouble<sup>H6862</sup>: for vain<sup>H7723</sup> is the help<sup>H8668</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup>. **13** Through God<sup>H430</sup> we shall do<sup>H6213</sup> valiantly<sup>H2428</sup>: for he it is that shall tread down<sup>H947</sup> our enemies<sup>H6862</sup>.
