

# Psalm 11

1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup>, A Psalm of David<sup>H1732</sup>. In the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> put I my trust<sup>H2620</sup>: how say<sup>H559</sup> ye to my soul<sup>H5315</sup>, Flee<sup>H5110</sup> as a bird<sup>H6833</sup> to your mountain<sup>H2022</sup>? 2 For, lo, the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> bend<sup>H1869</sup> their bow<sup>H7198</sup>, they make ready<sup>H3559</sup> their arrow<sup>H2671</sup> upon the string<sup>H3499</sup>, that they may privily<sup>H652 H1119</sup> shoot<sup>H3384</sup> at the upright<sup>H3477</sup> in heart<sup>H3820</sup>. 3 If the foundations<sup>H8356</sup> be destroyed<sup>H2040</sup>, what can the righteous<sup>H6662</sup> do<sup>H6466</sup>?

4 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is in his holy<sup>H6944</sup> temple<sup>H1964</sup>, the LORD'S<sup>H3068</sup> throne<sup>H3678</sup> is in heaven<sup>H8064</sup>: his eyes<sup>H5869</sup> behold<sup>H2372</sup>, his eyelids<sup>H6079</sup> try<sup>H974</sup>, the children<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>. 5 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> trieth<sup>H974</sup> the righteous<sup>H6662</sup>: but the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> and him that loveth<sup>H157</sup> violence<sup>H2555</sup> his soul<sup>H5315</sup> hateth<sup>H8130</sup>. 6 Upon the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> he shall rain<sup>H4305</sup> snares<sup>H6341</sup>, fire<sup>H784</sup> and brimstone<sup>H1614</sup>, and an horrible<sup>H2152</sup> tempest<sup>H7307</sup>: this shall be the portion<sup>H4521</sup> of their cup<sup>H3563</sup>. 7 For the righteous<sup>H6662</sup> LORD<sup>H3068</sup> loveth<sup>H157</sup> righteousness<sup>H6666</sup>; his countenance<sup>H6440</sup> doth behold<sup>H2372</sup> the upright<sup>H3477</sup>.
