If<sup>H3884</sup> it had not been the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> who was on our side, now may Israel<sup>H3478</sup> say<sup>H559</sup>; **2** If<sup>H3884</sup> it had not been the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> who was on our side, when men<sup>H120</sup> rose up<sup>H6965</sup> against us: **3** Then<sup>H233</sup> they had swallowed us up<sup>H1104</sup> quick<sup>H2416</sup>, when their wrath<sup>H639</sup> was kindled<sup>H2734</sup> against us: **4** Then<sup>H233</sup> the waters<sup>H4325</sup> had overwhelmed<sup>H7857</sup> us, the stream<sup>H5158</sup> had gone over<sup>H5674</sup> our soul<sup>H5315</sup>: **5** Then<sup>H233</sup> the proud<sup>H2121</sup> waters<sup>H4325</sup> had gone over<sup>H5674</sup> our soul<sup>H5315</sup>.

**6** Blessed<sup>H1288</sup> be the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, who hath not given<sup>H5414</sup> us as a prey<sup>H2964</sup> to their teeth<sup>H8127</sup>. **7** Our soul<sup>H5315</sup> is escaped<sup>H4422</sup> as a bird<sup>H6833</sup> out of the snare<sup>H6341</sup> of the fowlers<sup>H3369</sup>: the snare<sup>H6341</sup> is broken<sup>H7665</sup>, and we are escaped<sup>H4422</sup>. **8** Our help<sup>H5828</sup> is in the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, who made<sup>H6213</sup> heaven<sup>H8064</sup> and earth<sup>H776</sup>.
