

# Psalm 27

1 A Psalm of David<sup>H1732</sup>. The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is my light<sup>H216</sup> and my salvation<sup>H3468</sup>; whom shall I fear<sup>H3372</sup>? the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is the strength<sup>H4581</sup> of my life<sup>H2416</sup>; of whom shall I be afraid<sup>H6342</sup>? 2 When the wicked<sup>H7489</sup>, even mine enemies<sup>H6862</sup> and my foes<sup>H341</sup>, came<sup>H7126</sup> upon me to eat up<sup>H398</sup> my flesh<sup>H1320</sup>, they stumbled<sup>H3782</sup> and fell<sup>H5307</sup>. 3 Though an host<sup>H4264</sup> should encamp<sup>H2583</sup> against me, my heart<sup>H3820</sup> shall not fear<sup>H3372</sup>: though war<sup>H4421</sup> should rise<sup>H6965</sup> against me, in this will I be confident<sup>H982</sup>. 4 One<sup>H259</sup> thing have I desired<sup>H7592</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, that will I seek<sup>H1245</sup> after; that I may dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> all the days<sup>H3117</sup> of my life<sup>H2416</sup>, to behold<sup>H2372</sup> the beauty<sup>H5278</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and to enquire<sup>H1239</sup> in his temple<sup>H1964</sup>. 5 For in the time<sup>H3117</sup> of trouble<sup>H7451</sup> he shall hide<sup>H6845</sup> me in his pavilion<sup>H5520</sup>: in the secret<sup>H5643</sup> of his tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> shall he hide<sup>H5641</sup> me; he shall set me up<sup>H7311</sup> upon a rock<sup>H6697</sup>. 6 And now shall mine head<sup>H7218</sup> be lifted up<sup>H7311</sup> above mine enemies<sup>H341</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> me: therefore will I offer<sup>H2076</sup> in his tabernacle<sup>H168</sup> sacrifices<sup>H2077</sup> of joy<sup>H8643</sup>; I will sing<sup>H7891</sup>, yea, I will sing praises<sup>H2167</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.<sup>3</sup>

7 Hear<sup>H8085</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, when I cry<sup>H7121</sup> with my voice<sup>H6963</sup>: have mercy<sup>H2603</sup> also upon me, and answer<sup>H6030</sup> me. 8 When thou saidst, Seek<sup>H1245</sup> ye my face<sup>H6440</sup>; my heart<sup>H3820</sup> said<sup>H559</sup> unto thee, Thy face<sup>H6440</sup>, LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, will I seek<sup>H1245</sup>. 9 Hide<sup>H5641</sup> not thy face<sup>H6440</sup> far from me; put<sup>H5186</sup> not thy servant<sup>H5650</sup> away<sup>H5186</sup> in anger<sup>H639</sup>: thou hast been my help<sup>H5833</sup>; leave<sup>H5203</sup> me not, neither forsake<sup>H5800</sup> me, O God<sup>H430</sup> of my salvation<sup>H3468</sup>. 10 When my father<sup>H1</sup> and my mother<sup>H517</sup> forsake<sup>H5800</sup> me, then the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will take me up<sup>H622</sup>. 11 Teach<sup>H3384</sup> me thy way<sup>H1870</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and lead<sup>H5148</sup> me in a plain<sup>H4334</sup> path<sup>H734</sup>, because of mine enemies<sup>H8324</sup>.<sup>67</sup> 12 Deliver<sup>H5414</sup> me not over unto the will<sup>H5315</sup> of mine enemies<sup>H6862</sup>: for false<sup>H8267</sup> witnesses<sup>H5707</sup> are risen up<sup>H6965</sup> against me, and such as breathe out<sup>H3307</sup> cruelty<sup>H2555</sup>. 13 I had fainted, unless<sup>H3884</sup> I had believed<sup>H539</sup> to see<sup>H7200</sup> the goodness<sup>H2898</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup> of the living<sup>H2416</sup>. 14 Wait<sup>H6960</sup> on the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: be of good courage<sup>H2388</sup>, and he shall strengthen<sup>H553</sup> thine heart<sup>H3820</sup>: wait<sup>H6960</sup>, I say, on the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>.
