**6** There be many<sup>H7227</sup> that say<sup>H559</sup>, Who will shew<sup>H7200</sup> us any good<sup>H2896</sup>? LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, lift thou up<sup>H5375</sup> the light<sup>H216</sup> of thy countenance<sup>H6440</sup> upon us. **7** Thou hast put<sup>H5414</sup> gladness<sup>H8057</sup> in my heart<sup>H3820</sup>, more than in the time<sup>H6256</sup> that their corn<sup>H1715</sup> and their wine<sup>H8492</sup> increased<sup>H7231</sup>. **8** I will both<sup>H3162</sup> lay me down<sup>H7901</sup> in peace<sup>H7965</sup>, and sleep<sup>H3462</sup>: for thou, LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, only<sup>H910</sup> makest me dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in safety<sup>H983</sup>.
