

# Psalm 64

1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup>, A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. Hear<sup>H8085</sup> my voice<sup>H6963</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup>, in my prayer<sup>H7879</sup>: preserve<sup>H5341</sup> my life<sup>H2416</sup> from fear<sup>H6343</sup> of the enemy<sup>H341</sup>. 2 Hide<sup>H5641</sup> me from the secret counsel<sup>H5475</sup> of the wicked<sup>H7489</sup>; from the insurrection<sup>H7285</sup> of the workers<sup>H6466</sup> of iniquity<sup>H205</sup>. 3 Who whet<sup>H8150</sup> their tongue<sup>H3956</sup> like a sword<sup>H2719</sup>, and bend<sup>H1869</sup> their bows to shoot their arrows<sup>H2671</sup>, even bitter<sup>H4751</sup> words<sup>H1697</sup>: 4 That they may shoot<sup>H3384</sup> in secret<sup>H4565</sup> at the perfect<sup>H8535</sup>: suddenly<sup>H6597</sup> do they shoot<sup>H3384</sup> at him, and fear<sup>H3372</sup> not. 5 They encourage<sup>H2388</sup> themselves in an evil<sup>H7451</sup> matter<sup>H1697</sup>: they commune<sup>H5608</sup> of laying<sup>H2934</sup> snares<sup>H4170</sup> privily<sup>H2934</sup>; they say<sup>H559</sup>, Who shall see<sup>H7200</sup> them?<sup>12</sup> 6 They search out<sup>H2664</sup> iniquities<sup>H5766</sup>; they accomplish<sup>H8552</sup> a diligent<sup>H2664</sup> search<sup>H2665</sup>: both the inward<sup>H7130</sup> thought of every one<sup>H376</sup> of them, and the heart<sup>H3820</sup>, is deep<sup>H6013</sup> 34

7 But God<sup>H430</sup> shall shoot<sup>H3384</sup> at them with an arrow<sup>H2671</sup>; suddenly<sup>H6597</sup> shall they be wounded<sup>H4347</sup>. 5 8 So they shall make their own tongue<sup>H3956</sup> to fall<sup>H3782</sup> upon themselves: all that see<sup>H7200</sup> them shall flee away<sup>H5074</sup>. 9 And all men<sup>H120</sup> shall fear<sup>H3372</sup>, and shall declare<sup>H5046</sup> the work<sup>H6467</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>; for they shall wisely consider<sup>H7919</sup> of his doing<sup>H4639</sup>. 10 The righteous<sup>H6662</sup> shall be glad<sup>H8055</sup> in the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and shall trust<sup>H2620</sup> in him; and all the upright<sup>H3477</sup> in heart<sup>H3820</sup> shall glory<sup>H1984</sup>.
