

# Psalm 84

**1** To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup> upon Gittith<sup>H1665</sup>, A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> for the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Korah<sup>H7141</sup>. How amiable<sup>H3039</sup> are thy tabernacles<sup>H4908</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>! **2** My soul<sup>H5315</sup> longeth<sup>H3700</sup>, yea, even fainteth<sup>H3615</sup> for the courts<sup>H2691</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: my heart<sup>H3820</sup> and my flesh<sup>H1320</sup> crieth out<sup>H7442</sup> for the living<sup>H2416</sup> God<sup>H410</sup>. **3** Yea, the sparrow<sup>H6833</sup> hath found<sup>H4672</sup> an house<sup>H1004</sup>, and the swallow<sup>H1866</sup> a nest<sup>H7064</sup> for herself, where she may lay<sup>H7896</sup> her young<sup>H667</sup>, even thine altars<sup>H4196</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, my King<sup>H4428</sup>, and my God<sup>H430</sup>. **4** Blessed<sup>H835</sup> are they that dwell<sup>H3427</sup> in thy house<sup>H1004</sup>: they will be still praising<sup>H1984</sup> thee. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. **5** Blessed<sup>H835</sup> is the man<sup>H120</sup> whose strength<sup>H5797</sup> is in thee; in whose heart<sup>H3824</sup> are the ways<sup>H4546</sup> of them. **6** Who passing<sup>H5674</sup> through the valley<sup>H6010</sup> of Baca<sup>H1056 H1057</sup> make<sup>H7896</sup> it a well<sup>H4599</sup>, the rain<sup>H4175</sup> also filleth<sup>H5844</sup> the pools<sup>H1293 23</sup>. **7** They go<sup>H3212</sup> from strength<sup>H2428</sup> to strength<sup>H2428</sup>, every one of them in Zion<sup>H6726</sup> appeareth<sup>H7200</sup> before God<sup>H430</sup>.

**8** O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, hear<sup>H8085</sup> my prayer<sup>H8605</sup>: give ear<sup>H238</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. **9** Behold<sup>H7200</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup> our shield<sup>H4043</sup>, and look<sup>H5027</sup> upon the face<sup>H6440</sup> of thine anointed<sup>H4899</sup>. **10** For a day<sup>H3117</sup> in thy courts<sup>H2691</sup> is better<sup>H2896</sup> than a thousand<sup>H505</sup>. I had rather<sup>H977</sup> be a doorkeeper<sup>H5605</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of my God<sup>H430</sup>, than to dwell<sup>H1752</sup> in the tents<sup>H168</sup> of wickedness<sup>H7562</sup>. **11** For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> is a sun<sup>H8121</sup> and shield<sup>H4043</sup>: the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will give<sup>H5414</sup> grace<sup>H2580</sup> and glory<sup>H3519</sup>: no good<sup>H2896</sup> thing will he withhold<sup>H4513</sup> from them that walk<sup>H1980</sup> uprightly<sup>H8549</sup>. **12** O LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, blessed<sup>H835</sup> is the man<sup>H120</sup> that trusteth<sup>H982</sup> in thee.
