

# Psalm 85

1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup>, A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> for the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Korah<sup>H7141</sup>. LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, thou hast been favourable<sup>H7521</sup> unto thy land<sup>H776</sup>: thou hast brought back<sup>H7725</sup> the captivity<sup>H7622 H7622</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>. 12 2 Thou hast forgiven<sup>H5375</sup> the iniquity<sup>H5771</sup> of thy people<sup>H5971</sup>, thou hast covered<sup>H3680</sup> all their sin<sup>H2403</sup>. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. 3 Thou hast taken away<sup>H622</sup> all thy wrath<sup>H5678</sup>: thou hast turned<sup>H7725</sup> thyself from the fierceness<sup>H2740</sup> of thine anger<sup>H639</sup>. 3 4 Turn<sup>H7725</sup> us, O God<sup>H430</sup> of our salvation<sup>H3468</sup>, and cause thine anger<sup>H3708</sup> toward us to cease<sup>H6565</sup>. 5 Wilt thou be angry<sup>H599</sup> with us for ever<sup>H5769</sup>? wilt thou draw out<sup>H4900</sup> thine anger<sup>H639</sup> to all<sup>H1755</sup> generations<sup>H1755</sup>? 6 Wilt thou not revive<sup>H2421</sup> us again<sup>H7725</sup>: that thy people<sup>H5971</sup> may rejoice<sup>H8055</sup> in thee? 7 Shew<sup>H7200</sup> us thy mercy<sup>H2617</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and grant<sup>H5414</sup> us thy salvation<sup>H3468</sup>.

8 I will hear<sup>H8085</sup> what God<sup>H410</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> will speak<sup>H1696</sup>: for he will speak<sup>H1696</sup> peace<sup>H7965</sup> unto his people<sup>H5971</sup>, and to his saints<sup>H2623</sup>: but let them not turn again<sup>H7725</sup> to folly<sup>H3690</sup>. 9 Surely his salvation<sup>H3468</sup> is nigh<sup>H7138</sup> them that fear<sup>H3373</sup> him; that glory<sup>H3519</sup> may dwell<sup>H7931</sup> in our land<sup>H776</sup>. 10 Mercy<sup>H2617</sup> and truth<sup>H571</sup> are met together<sup>H6298</sup>, righteousness<sup>H6664</sup> and peace<sup>H7965</sup> have kissed<sup>H5401</sup> each other. 11 Truth<sup>H571</sup> shall spring out<sup>H6779</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>; and righteousness<sup>H6664</sup> shall look down<sup>H8259</sup> from heaven<sup>H8064</sup>. 12 Yea, the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall give<sup>H5414</sup> that which is good<sup>H2896</sup>, and our land<sup>H776</sup> shall yield<sup>H5414</sup> her increase<sup>H2981</sup>. 13 Righteousness<sup>H6664</sup> shall go<sup>H1980</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> him; and shall set<sup>H7760</sup> us in the way<sup>H1870</sup> of his steps<sup>H6471</sup>.
