

# Psalm 92

1 A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> or Song<sup>H7892</sup> for the sabbath<sup>H7676</sup> day<sup>H3117</sup>. It is a good<sup>H2896</sup> thing to give thanks<sup>H3034</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and to sing praises<sup>H2167</sup> unto thy name<sup>H8034</sup>, O most High<sup>H5945</sup>. 2 To shew forth<sup>H5046</sup> thy lovingkindness<sup>H2617</sup> in the morning<sup>H1242</sup>, and thy faithfulness<sup>H530</sup> every night<sup>H3915</sup>. 1 3 Upon an instrument of ten strings<sup>H6218</sup>, and upon the psaltery<sup>H5035</sup>, upon the harp<sup>H3658</sup> with a solemn sound<sup>H1902</sup>. 23 4 For thou, LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, hast made me glad<sup>H8055</sup> through thy work<sup>H6467</sup>: I will triumph<sup>H7442</sup> in the works<sup>H4639</sup> of thy hands<sup>H3027</sup>. 5 O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, how great<sup>H1431</sup> are thy works<sup>H4639</sup>! and thy thoughts<sup>H4284</sup> are very<sup>H3966</sup> deep<sup>H6009</sup>. 6 A brutish<sup>H1198</sup> man<sup>H376</sup> knoweth<sup>H3045</sup> not; neither doth a fool<sup>H3684</sup> understand<sup>H995</sup> this.

7 When the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> spring<sup>H6524</sup> as the grass<sup>H6212</sup>, and when all the workers<sup>H6466</sup> of iniquity<sup>H205</sup> do flourish<sup>H6692</sup>; it is that they shall be destroyed<sup>H8045</sup> for ever<sup>H5703</sup>. 8 But thou, LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, art most high<sup>H4791</sup> for evermore<sup>H5769</sup>. 9 For, lo, thine enemies<sup>H341</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, for, lo, thine enemies<sup>H341</sup> shall perish<sup>H6</sup>; all the workers<sup>H6466</sup> of iniquity<sup>H205</sup> shall be scattered<sup>H6504</sup>. 10 But my horn<sup>H7161</sup> shalt thou exalt<sup>H7311</sup> like the horn of an unicorn<sup>H7214</sup>: I shall be anointed<sup>H1101</sup> with fresh<sup>H7488</sup> oil<sup>H8081</sup>. 11 Mine eye<sup>H5869</sup> also shall see<sup>H5027</sup> my desire on mine enemies<sup>H7790</sup>, and mine ears<sup>H241</sup> shall hear<sup>H8085</sup> my desire of the wicked<sup>H7489</sup> that rise up<sup>H6965</sup> against me. 12 The righteous<sup>H6662</sup> shall flourish<sup>H6524</sup> like the palm tree<sup>H8558</sup>: he shall grow<sup>H7685</sup> like a cedar<sup>H730</sup> in Lebanon<sup>H3844</sup>. 13 Those that be planted<sup>H8362</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall flourish<sup>H6524</sup> in the courts<sup>H2691</sup> of our God<sup>H430</sup>. 14 They shall still bring forth fruit<sup>H5107</sup> in old age<sup>H7872</sup>, they shall be fat<sup>H1879</sup> and flourishing<sup>H7488</sup>, 4 15 To shew<sup>H5046</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is upright<sup>H3477</sup>: he is my rock<sup>H6697</sup>, and there is no unrighteousness<sup>H5766</sup> H5766 in him.
