

# Psalm 95

1 O come<sup>H3212</sup>, let us sing<sup>H7442</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: let us make a joyful noise<sup>H7321</sup> to the rock<sup>H6697</sup> of our salvation<sup>H3468</sup>.  
2 Let us come<sup>H6923</sup> before his presence<sup>H6440</sup> with thanksgiving<sup>H8426</sup>, and make a joyful noise<sup>H7321</sup> unto him with psalms<sup>H2158</sup>.<sup>1</sup> 3 For the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is a great<sup>H1419</sup> God<sup>H410</sup>, and a great<sup>H1419</sup> King<sup>H4428</sup> above all gods<sup>H430</sup>. 4 In his hand<sup>H3027</sup> are the deep places<sup>H4278</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>: the strength<sup>H8443</sup> of the hills<sup>H2022</sup> is his also.<sup>23</sup> 5 The sea<sup>H3220</sup> is his, and he made<sup>H6213</sup> it: and his hands<sup>H3027</sup> formed<sup>H3335</sup> the dry<sup>H3006</sup> land.<sup>4</sup> 6 O come<sup>H935</sup>, let us worship<sup>H7812</sup> and bow down<sup>H3766</sup>: let us kneel<sup>H1288</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our maker<sup>H6213</sup>.

7 For he is our God<sup>H430</sup>; and we are the people<sup>H5971</sup> of his pasture<sup>H4830</sup>, and the sheep<sup>H6629</sup> of his hand<sup>H3027</sup>. To day<sup>H3117</sup> if ye will hear<sup>H8085</sup> his voice<sup>H6963</sup>, 8 Harden<sup>H7185</sup> not your heart<sup>H3824</sup>, as in the provocation<sup>H4808</sup>, and as in the day<sup>H3117</sup> of temptation<sup>H4531</sup> in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 9 When your fathers<sup>H1</sup> tempted<sup>H5254</sup> me, proved<sup>H974</sup> me, and saw<sup>H7200</sup> my work<sup>H6467</sup>. 10 Forty<sup>H705</sup> years<sup>H8141</sup> long was I grieved<sup>H6962</sup> with this generation<sup>H1755</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup>, It is a people<sup>H5971</sup> that do err<sup>H8582</sup> in their heart<sup>H3824</sup>, and they have not known<sup>H3045</sup> my ways<sup>H1870</sup>: 11 Unto whom I swear<sup>H7650</sup> in my wrath<sup>H639</sup> that they should not enter<sup>H935</sup> into my rest<sup>H4496</sup>.<sup>6</sup>
