1 Put<sup>G5279</sup> them<sup>G846</sup> in mind<sup>G5279</sup> to be subject<sup>G5293</sup> to principalities<sup>G746</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> powers<sup>G1849</sup>, to obey magistrates<sup>G3980</sup>, to be<sup>G1511</sup> ready<sup>G2092</sup> to<sup>G4314</sup> every<sup>G3956</sup> good<sup>G18</sup> work<sup>G2041</sup>, 2 To speak evil of<sup>G987</sup> no man<sup>G3367</sup>, to be<sup>G1511</sup> no brawlers<sup>G269</sup>, but gentle<sup>G1933</sup>, shewing<sup>G1731</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> meekness<sup>G4236</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup> men<sup>G444</sup>. 3 For<sup>G1063</sup> we ourselves<sup>G2249</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> were<sup>G2258</sup> G453 sometimes<sup>G4218</sup> foolish<sup>G453</sup>, disobedient<sup>G545</sup>, deceived<sup>G4105</sup>, serving<sup>G1398</sup> divers<sup>G4164</sup> lusts<sup>G1939</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> pleasures<sup>G2237</sup>, living<sup>G1236</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> malice<sup>G2549</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> envy<sup>G5355</sup>, hateful<sup>G4767</sup>, and hating<sup>G3404</sup> one another<sup>G240</sup>. 4 But<sup>G1161</sup> after<sup>G3753</sup> that the kindness<sup>G5544</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> love<sup>G5363</sup> of God<sup>G2316</sup> our<sup>G2257</sup> Saviour<sup>G4990</sup> toward man<sup>G5363</sup> appeared<sup>G2014</sup>, 5 Not<sup>G3756</sup> by<sup>G1537</sup> works<sup>G2041</sup> of<sup>G1722</sup> righteousness<sup>G1343</sup> which<sup>G3739</sup> we<sup>G2249</sup> have done<sup>G4160</sup>, but<sup>G235</sup> according to<sup>G2596</sup> his<sup>G846</sup> mercy<sup>G1656</sup> he saved<sup>G4982</sup> us<sup>G2248</sup>, by<sup>G1223</sup> the washing<sup>G3067</sup> of regeneration<sup>G3824</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> renewing<sup>G342</sup> of the Holy<sup>G40</sup> Ghost<sup>G4151</sup>; 6 Which<sup>G3739</sup> he shed<sup>G1632</sup> on<sup>G1909</sup> us<sup>G2248</sup> abundantly<sup>G4146</sup> through<sup>G1223</sup> Jesus<sup>G2424</sup> Christ<sup>G5547</sup> our<sup>G2257</sup> Saviour<sup>G4990</sup>, 7 That<sup>G2443</sup> being justified by<sup>G1344</sup> his<sup>G1565</sup> grace<sup>G5485</sup>, we should be made<sup>G1096</sup> heirs<sup>G2818</sup> according to<sup>G2596</sup> the hope<sup>G1680</sup> of eternal<sup>G166</sup> life<sup>G2222</sup>. 8 This is a faithful<sup>G4103</sup> saying<sup>G3056</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> these things<sup>G4012</sup> G5130 I will<sup>G1014</sup> that thou<sup>G4571</sup> affirm constantly<sup>G1226</sup>, that<sup>G2443</sup> they which have believed<sup>G4100</sup> in God<sup>G2316</sup> might be careful<sup>G5431</sup> to maintain<sup>G4291</sup> good<sup>G2570</sup> works<sup>G2041</sup>. These things<sup>G5023</sup> are<sup>G2076</sup> good<sup>G2570</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> profitable<sup>G5624</sup> unto men<sup>G444</sup>.

9 But<sup>G1161</sup> avoid<sup>G4026</sup> foolish<sup>G3474</sup> questions<sup>G2214</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> genealogies<sup>G1076</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> contentions<sup>G2054</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> strivings about<sup>G3163</sup> the law<sup>G3544</sup>; for<sup>G1063</sup> they are<sup>G1526</sup> unprofitable<sup>G512</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> vain<sup>G3152</sup>. 10 A man<sup>G444</sup> that is an heretick<sup>G141</sup> after<sup>G3326</sup> the first<sup>G3391</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> second<sup>G1208</sup> admonition<sup>G3559</sup> reject<sup>G3868</sup>, 11 Knowing<sup>G1492</sup> that<sup>G3754</sup> he that is such<sup>G5108</sup> is subverted<sup>G1612</sup>, and<sup>G2532</sup> sinneth<sup>G264</sup>, being<sup>G5607</sup> condemned of himself<sup>G843</sup>. 12 When<sup>G3752</sup> I shall send<sup>G3992</sup> Artemas<sup>G734</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup>, or<sup>G2228</sup> Tychicus<sup>G5190</sup>, be diligent<sup>G4704</sup> to come<sup>G2064</sup> unto<sup>G4314</sup> me<sup>G3165</sup> to<sup>G1519</sup> Nicopolis<sup>G3533</sup>: for<sup>G1063</sup> I have determined<sup>G2919</sup> there<sup>G1563</sup> to winter<sup>G3914</sup>. 13 Bring<sup>G4311</sup> Zenas<sup>G2211</sup> the lawyer<sup>G3544</sup> and<sup>G2532</sup> Apollos<sup>G625</sup> on their journey<sup>G4311</sup> diligently<sup>G4709</sup>, that<sup>G2443</sup> nothing<sup>G3367</sup> be wanting<sup>G3007</sup> unto them<sup>G846</sup>. 14 And<sup>G1161</sup> let<sup>G3129</sup> ours<sup>G2251</sup> also<sup>G2532</sup> learn<sup>G3129</sup> to maintain<sup>G4291</sup> good<sup>G2570</sup> works<sup>G2041</sup> for<sup>G1519</sup> necessary<sup>G316</sup> uses<sup>G5532</sup>, that<sup>G3363</sup> they be<sup>G5600</sup> not<sup>G3363</sup> unfruitful<sup>G175</sup>. 15 All<sup>G3956</sup> that are with<sup>G3326</sup> me<sup>G1700</sup> salute<sup>G782</sup> thee<sup>G4571</sup>. Greet<sup>G782</sup> them that love<sup>G5368</sup> us<sup>G2248</sup> in<sup>G1722</sup> the faith<sup>G4102</sup>. Grace<sup>G5485</sup> be with<sup>G3326</sup> you<sup>G5216</sup> all<sup>G3956</sup>. Amen<sup>G281</sup>. 4
